They would make a rusty irritating sound every time you open or close your storage unit. If you have heard any of such sounds, then make sure to address them without wasting any time further. The best way to do it is by lubricating it.

Tighten Bolts

The onsite storage unit is portable, which means it would have been placed before you rented it; when a container is on the move, the chance of bolts losing increases. The lost bolts would have an impact on the stuff, especially during bad weather conditions.

Look For Rubber Plugs

The major reason for the presence of a rubber plug is to ensure that moisture does not affect the stuff inside the container. Further, it makes sure that the container does not get rust. It is uncommon to find the rubber plugs missing but is necessary to ensure. This way, you would be keeping your storage unit safe against moisture.



Make Sure Decals Are Intact

The last thing that may come to your mind when expecting the storage unit is the decal, but it is something that you would require to ensure that are in place and legible.

Replace Weather Stripping And Caulking

The only fear that the container renters have is somehow, the container would get the moisture in, and all the stuff would spoil. Getting the mould in the stuff is real, especially if it has moisture. The weather stripping and caulking would ensure that moisture does not get in the storage unit.
